Bible Verses

- JOSHUA 1:9 Be strong and courageous. Do not be terrified; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go."
- PSALM 16:8 I have set the LORD always before me. Because he is at my right hand, I will not be shaken.
- PSALM 23:1 The LORD is my shepherd, I shall lack nothing.
- PSALM 27:1 The LORD is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid?
- PSALM 37:5 Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him and he will do this.
- PSALM 46:1 God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.
- PSALM 118: 28 You are my God, and I will give you thanks; You are my God, and I will exalt You.
- PSALM 119:105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path.
- PROVERBS 30:5 Every word of God is flawless; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him.
- ISAIAH 41:10 So do not fear for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.
- ISAIAH 43:1 But now, this is what the LORD says—"Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name; you are mine."
- JEREMIAH 29:11 "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."
- MATTHEW 6:33 "Seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well."
- MATTHEW 28:20 "Surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."
- LUKE 11:28 "Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it."
- JOHN 3:16 "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
- JOHN 8:12 "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

- JOHN 8:31-32 "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."
- JOHN 10:27-28 My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand.
- JOHN 14:6 "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."
- JOHN 14:27 "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid."
- JOHN 15:5 "I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing."
- ROMANS 1:16 I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes.
- ROMANS 5:8 But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
- ROMANS 8:28 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.
- ROMANS 8:38 For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- EPHESIANS 2:8-9 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast.
- EPHESIANS 2:10 For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
- EPHESIANS 5:1 Be imitators of God, therefore, as dearly loved children.
- PHILIPPIANS 1:6 He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
- PHILIPPIANS 4:13 I can do everything through him who gives me strength.
- COLOSSIANS 3:17 And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.
- HEBREWS 13:5 Be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."
- 1 PETER 5:7 Cast all your anxiety on him, because he cares for you.
- 1 JOHN 3:1 How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God!
- REVELATION 2:10 "Be faithful, even to the point of death, and I will give you the crown of life."
- GALATIANS 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

I PETER 3:15 But in your hearts set apart Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect.

PHILIPPIANS 4:8 Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.

II CORINTHIANS 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!

I JOHN 1:8-9 If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
